- (iv) United Utilities Water PLC (UUW) reserve the right to make such enquiries about an applicant as they consider necessary in assessing their application.

Guidance notes

The purpose of this questionnaire is to allow United Utilities Water PLC (U UW) to obtain relevant background information with which to make an initial assessment of your application for access to the U UW potable water network. It is in your interests to provide as much information in the Stage 1 questionnaire, to enable the process to be efficient and effective.

Please attach securely to the completed questionnaire all maps and plans and other supplementary data requested.

If you continue to progress to Stage 2 of the application process, a more detailed questionnaire will be sent to you to obtain additional information to progress the application.

1. General Company Information

These are the details referring to the Applicant, the Applicant being the party that will enter into a contractual agreement with U UW, subject to approval. Contact details must be for the nominated contact person. This person must be able to act on the company's behalf in respect of Common Carriage on the U UW network. The Applicant must be able to provide details of the company's registered office, company registration and licence details and confirm eligibility.

2. Outline Application

2.1 Full details of the source are required. This includes a full 10 – digit national grid reference for the source location and name, type of source and the yield of the source.

2.2 Details must be provided of any water quality monitoring carried out at source. This is to ensure that the standard of water quality is acceptable. Any contingency plans for drought and supply failure must also be provided.

2.3 Details must be provided of any treatment work that would be required for the source before entering the network.

2.4 Details must be provided about whether the source is fluoridated before entry into the U UW network.

2.5 The proposed point of entry is the point at which the Applicant wishes to access our network. If the access point is unclear, please indicate the location of the source and we will aim to identify access points where sufficient capacity exists for your source to enter the network. These access points will be confirmed at a subsequent stage.

2.6 The exit point of supply is the point where the Applicant proposes to leave U UW network. This may either be to the customer or transfer to another network. If you are unsure where you wish to exit our network please indicate the location of the destination of the water and we will attempt to find a suitable place for exit from our network. Details of the exit point are required including a full 10-digit national grid reference for the exit point and details of flow patterns and monitoring.

2.7 Details of proposed start and end dates are required to take other network demands into account. An indication of the period for which you require access is also required. Details are also required of the customers to be supplied and any input meters that will be used to measure the flow of water into the U UW network.
