

# Make your own mini water butt



Saving water is really important, and we can all save together! Why not make your own mini water butt – and catch that lovely rainwater to re-use watering the plants.

## You will need:

- An empty milk container – 4 or 6 pints work best! (Make sure you keep the lid)
- Garden twine or string
- Scissors
- Your favourite crafting accessories! Glue, stickers, feathers – whatever you can get your hands on!

## Step 1

Rinse out the milk container and remove the label



## Step 2

Ask an adult for help, and carefully cut off the base of the milk carton



## Step 3

This is where the fun begins! Decorate your milk carton using our fun H<sub>2</sub>O hero stickers – or create your own! Just remember that the lid of the bottle will be at the bottom when your water butt is finished!



## Step 4

Using the string or twine, tie your bottle securely to an outside fence, making sure it is strong enough to hold when it's full of water. You can do this by tying the string through the handle, around the base – and back again!



## Step 5

Watch your butt fill up! When it rains, your water butt will fill up with water, and you can use it to water your plants by carefully unscrewing the lid and placing a watering can underneath.
