## Letter of Support for United Utilities Green Recovery Proposals

As an organisation involved in the protection and enhancement of the environment and communities, and as the Host organisation for the Irwell Catchment Partnership, we are keen to engage with partners to develop new initiatives that help to further these objectives.

Having been involved in the development of the proposals that United Utilities would look to deliver we are pleased to note that these support the ambitions of the Irwell Catchment Plan and that a partnership approach has been taken in identifying what can be achieved and how best it can be delivered.

We are keen to work in partnership with United Utilities and others, to align delivery and maximise the results that can be achieved, and are particularly supportive of the proposals put forward to enhance the River Irwell catchment, which include:

- Tackling invasive species at a catchment level to improve access to the river, restore native biodiversity, reduce health and safety risk and prevent further spread
- Catchment phosphorus management to reduce rural and urban pollution in line with the requirements of the water framework directive as well as reducing other urban pollutants
- Sustainable drainage and natural flood management to reduce flooding associated with surface water and sewers
